

Mr. Pernes Samuel Attended Training at Brisbane, Australia

On 2nd – 4th of May 2018, Pernes attended a training hosted by Pacific Integrity Network (PIN), an alliance of anti-corruption and integrity organization from across the Pacific. Eleven participants from FSM, Republic of the Marshall Islands, Kingdom of Tonga, Samoa, Papua New Guinea, Solomon Islands and Vanuatu attended the training.

The three-day program included a day in Brisbane Commonwealth Ombudsman Office, attending lectures on how they engage in the deliberation of their duties and responsibilities, and on an investigation case management system called Resolve.

The following two days were spent at the Australian Institute of Management where the training shifted to Project Management, where participants learned skills, tools and productive processes essential for conducting successful projects; and Leading with Emotional Intelligence where improving individual's conduct and behavior is emphasized and important to well-being and success of an individual.

The training is another successful step in the National Public Auditor's constant pursuit of improving and refining his staffs' knowledge and skills in the auditing and investigation field.
