

ONPA Auditors attend PASAI Performance Auditing Workshop in Guam

Two of ONPA's audit staff participated in the Fundamentals of Performance Auditing Workshop from March 11 – 15, 2026. The workshop was organized by the Pacific Association of Supreme Audit Institutions (PASAI) and hosted in Guam.

The five-day workshop brought together 20 government auditors from across the North Pacific, including representatives from the Federated States of Micronesia (ONPA, Pohnpei, Chuuk, Yap, and Kosrae OPA), Guam, the Marshall Islands, and Palau. The training focused on building practical skills in planning, conducting, and reporting performance audits.

The workshop was led by PASAI Program Director Meegan Reinhard and Karen Wong from The Audit Office of New Zealand, who guided participants through the fundamentals of performance auditing. Topics covered included understanding audit objectives, developing audit criteria, gathering of evidence, analyzing findings, and preparing impactful audit reports.

The workshop also provided a valuable opportunity for auditors to exchange experiences, share best practices, and strengthen professional networks that help support strong government accountability practices. Through this training, participants strengthened their ability to evaluate public programs and provide recommendations that promote accountability, transparency, and improved government performance.
